2. <u>Purchasing Firearms from a Licensed Dealer:</u> O.C.G.A. § 16-11-172

"(a) All transfers or purchases of firearms conducted by a licensed importer, licensed manufacturer, or licensed dealer shall be subject to the NICS."

U.S.C. § 922(t)(3) and 27 C.F.R. § 478.102(d)

"(t) (1) ... a licensed importer, licensed manufacturer or licensed dealer shall not transfer a firearm unless ... the licensee contacts the national instant criminal [NICS] background check system...

(3) Paragraph (1) **shall not apply ... if** ... (A)(1) such person has presented to the licensee **a permit that ... (I) allows such person to possess or acquire a firearm**; and (II) was issued not more than 5 years earlier by the State in which the transfer is to take place..."

3. <u>Confirmation that you ARE a "Lawful Weapons Carrier":</u> O.C.G.A. § 16-11-125.1

"(2.1) 'Lawful weapons carrier' means any person who is not prohibited by law from possessing a weapon or long gun, **any person licensed pursuant to Code Section 16-11-129**, ..."

(3) 'License holder' means a person who holds a valid weapons carry license."
